



Parent Guide

Step 1: Make a plan for when you will hold piano lessons for your child. Consistency is beneficial when learning a new skill.

Step 2: Before starting the lesson, print out the corresponding materials.

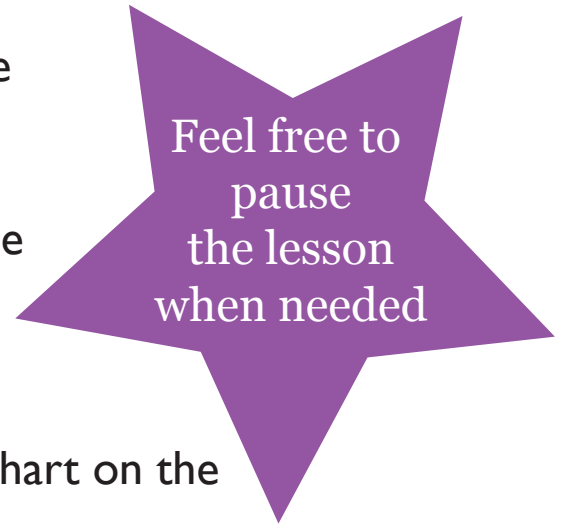
Step 3: Set your child up for their lesson on the piano with the device of your choice to play the lesson.

Step 4: Instruct your child to place the piano chart on the piano.

Step 5: Start the lesson and stay nearby to help your child when needed.

Step 6: Direct your child to finish the theory page after the lesson is over.

Step 7: Direct your child to practice daily.



If your child isn't able to play along with the song the first time, try these:

- Pause the lesson and let them try on their own.
- Use a pencil to point to each note as they play.
- Once they are a little more comfortable resume the lesson.
- Slow down the playback speed if it's still too fast.

Students might need your help to find
their hand position at the beginning.
This is normal.
